The explosion of interest in generative AI (GenAI) such as ChatGPT has created a need for prompt engineering expertise to optimize practitioners' interactions with GenAI and enable them to take advantage of the many powerful capabilities of this technology in all areas of their practice. However, the prompt engineering skills are still not widely covered. This workshop style event aims to help you learn about prompt engineering and how you can use generative AI to your work and areas of interest.

This workshop will cover approaches for addressing a variety of issues of interest to workshop participants. Discover the Task Amplification Categories (TACs) framework—a structured method to align GenAl's capabilities with workplace challenges such as drafting internal reports, enhancing team communication, and streamlining documentation processes. Learn to navigate the "blank canvas" of Al with focused applications that boost productivity and improve work quality. This session provides actionable strategies and real-world examples to harness GenAl effectively, enhancing workplace efficiency and effectiveness.
